PLAGUES & PLEASURES is the award-winning true story of a motley band of eccentrics and their remarkable relationship with the former resort town turned post-apocalyptic paradise. The film has received rave reviews throughout the US and Canada with the *Christian Science Monitor's* Peter Rainer describing it as a "One-of-a-kind documentary... The filmmakers, in cooperation with several non-profits, have launched a letter writing campaign to Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger in memory of the late Congressman Sonny Bono, a champion of the Salton Sea.

The film has quickly become a cult classic and the Salton Sea is now the ultimate alternative tourist destination, as people from across the country come to visit Donald the Nudist, donate paint to Leonard's mountain, and catch a drink with Hunky Daddy.
